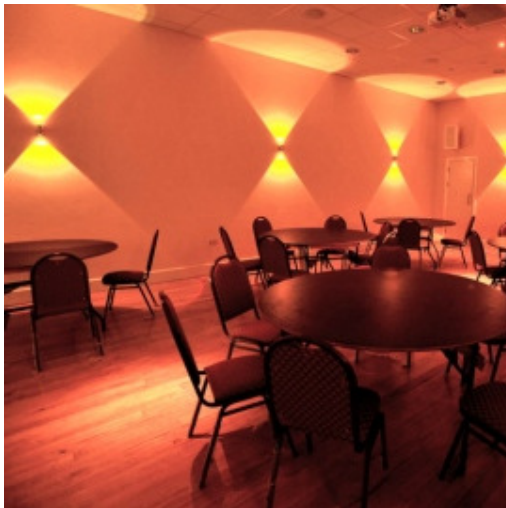


Case Study



Golden Lion, Maryport, Cumbria

The golden Lion in Maryport, Cumbria has seen many changes over the years, in its heyday it hosted Charles Dickens and George Stephenson. In the past few years it was nominated as one of Cumbria's 10 worst eyesores. Now it has been fully refurbished to its former glory by local businessman Philip Cueto.



Avonics have installed a complete audio, video and lighting system. Any music source can be played into any of the four zones, these include CD player, Sky TV, Media player or freeview as well as input points for quiz nights and DJs. The

first floor function room provides a multifunction space with full AV facilities. A substantial sound system using T&M speakers, Crown amplification and digital speaker management system is suitable for DJs as well as public meetings or corporate events. A video projector and screen can display from Sky HD, Freeview, DVD, media player or laptop input point.

The highlight of the room is the 12 LED colour changing wall lights and 'top table' lighting. The LED wall lights can set the mood in the room with static colours or slow colour fades, or they can be used for discos and dances with stunning faster chases and effects. The ground floor bar area uses ceiling speakers to relay the audio from Sky HD or music system. Two plasma screens, 50" and 46", have HDMI distribution to give the full benefit of the Sky HD system.
